the bible. Alongside this for all the services in August, anyone that would like to is welcome to bring a picnic to share in the grounds after the service.




24 July	Fruit Salad	Genesis 3:1-15, Luke 23:32-43 The fall finds ultimate redemption in Christ.

14 August	Passover Lamb	Exodus 12:21-28, Mark 14:12-26 The first passover and the last supper.
21 August	Fish for 5000	Isaiah 55:1-5, Matthew 14:13-21 Miraculous provision is in our God's nature.
28 August	Heavenly Feast	Isaiah 25:6-9, Luke 14:12-24 One final banquet at the end of time.
